EAST FALLS VILLAGE MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

I/we wish to join East Falls Village under the terms and conditions described in this Membership Agreement:

I understand that East Falls Village (EFV) is a volunteer-driven part of the East Falls Community Council; that EFV is designed to assist people who want to remain in their homes as long as possible. I understand that East Falls Village members and other East Falls residents volunteer to assist EFV members and that these volunteers serve without compensation. I understand that these services are provided with no warranty. I will not ask volunteers to perform duties that would put them, me, my property, or others at risk. I will not ask them to do things that require professional training, expertise or licenses.

EFV has a list of volunteer drivers willing to assist EFV members with rides to medical appointments, food shopping, and the like. However, EFV cannot guarantee the availability of a driver at all times. While EFV will help to schedule this service, volunteer drivers are not controlled by EFCC or EFV. I understand that volunteer drivers have no special training and that accepting a ride from a volunteer entails the same risk as I would take by accepting a ride from any other driver of similar age and experience. I will not seek to hold either EFCC or EFV responsible for loss or injury I may suffer as a result of having accepted a ride from such a volunteer.

EFV maintains a list of contractors, professionals, and other businesses that has been compiled based on recommendations of other EFV members. These contractors, professionals, and/or businesses are not controlled by EFCC or EFV. They will deal directly with me. It is up to me to determine whether they are qualified, what I wish them to do, and how they are to do it. I understand that EFV does not guarantee the work of these contractors, professionals, or other businesses in any way. I understand that if I encounter a problem with any of these contractors, professionals, or other businesses, I must resolve the problem with the contractor, professional, or business. I will not hold either EFCC or EFV responsible for such problems or their consequences.

Because I understand that EFV and EFCC are volunteer groups and not professional service providers, I will not hold either EFV or EFCC responsible for any loss or injury resulting from my participation in EFV -sponsored activities and/or my use of EFV services and/or contractors, professionals, or other businesses I may select from the EFV list. I understand that this agreement is a requirement of my membership in EFV.
